At a total of 25 locations throughout Vienna, children had the opportunity to participate in a wide range of activities, involving sports, games and fun. The first summer confirmed that there is great demand for such an offer: **In all, around 6,200 children visited the 25 camps throughout Vienna in 2019, of which 1,200 school children also availed of learning aids, free of charge.**

The popularity of the programme is of course a motivation for us to continue the Summer City Camps: Once again this year, in co-operation with professional partner organisations, a **top-class and reasonably-priced holiday programme** will be organised in Vienna. As well as fun and games, there will also be learning support at selected locations, with targeted assistance in German, mathematics and English.

I wish every child a wonderful summer, and look forward to hearing about many great experiences!

SUMMER CITY CAMPS: HOLIDAYS THAT ARE FUN

The Summer City Camps encompass three different **programmes**, which are each tailored to the individual needs of children and young people. The following programmes can be **selected** during registration:

Children's programme

Children aged between **6 – 12** can expect all **kinds of fun, games and adventure** in the Summer City Camps. Exercise is once again a major focus in 2020, but also excursions into nature, cultural experiences and workshops on creativity, the natural sciences, technology and much more are on offer, as well as **swimming lessons**.

Youth programme

This programme focuses on targeted **learning support** in the subjects of German, mathematics and English. The free two-week learning courses take place in the mornings, and are aimed at young people in **middle school, AHS lower cycle and polytechnical school**. Optionally, it is also possible to attend a leisure programme especially for youths in the afternoon, which is subject to a charge.

Programme for children with disabilities

The Summer City Camps also offer the **professional care** of children with disabilities during the holidays. Children will have the opportunity to enjoy fun and adventurous holidays at various school locations! The idea of inclusion will be implemented in many different ways.

ALL OF THE IMPORTANT INFORMATION

When do the Summer City Camps take place?

The Summer City Camps will be held in **Vienna** from **6 July to 4 September 2020**. Children can be registered weekly for a camp, for the whole day from **8.00 a.m. to 5.00 p.m.** A healthy lunch is included. It is possible to bring children from 7.15 a.m. and to collect them by no later than 6.00 p.m.

Where are the camps located?

All locations in Vienna are listed in detail on our website at **www.summercycamp.at**.

Who can take part?

The offer applies to **all school-age Viennese children aged between 6 and 14**, who live in Vienna and who do not yet have a place in Campus locations or in day-care centres.

How much do the camps cost?

The cost for one child is **50 Euro per week, including lunch**. The cost for a **second and third child is 25 Euro each**. From the **fourth child, participation is free of charge**. Equally, children receiving primary care or means-tested minimum income may avail of the offer free of charge. In this case, please bring notice of your means-tested minimum income or proof of your asylum application status with you when registering.
